

CONTEST RULES BEAWINNER.CA 2012

1. ELIGIBILITY

The contest is being held by **Formation professionnelle et technique Gaspésie – Îles-de-la-Madeleine** and is open to all residents of Québec.

2. HOW TO ENTER THE CONTEST AND DESCRIPTION OF THE PRIZES

2.1. The “BEAWINNER” publicity contest begins on February 1st, 2012 and ends at 11:59 p.m. on March 30, 2012.

2.2. Participants must complete the information request form on the Internet site <http://www.beawinner.ca> and give their contact information.

All requests must be received no later than 11:59 p.m. on March 30, 2012.

Only one entry per participant is allowed.

2.3. Prize Drawing

On April 2, 2012, a random drawing will be held to draw one (1) entry from all the eligible entries received between February 1st, 2012 and 11:59 p.m. on March 30, 2012.
